ABOUT RECITAL COSTUMES AND RECITAL FEES

Spring recital costumes are ordered in the winter because the costume companies require several months to prepare such a large number of costumes. We measure your student for their costume beginning in November.

Recital Costumes are \$60 + tax for all combos, and all classes up to 7-9 year olds.

Recital Costumes are \$65 + tax for all 9-11 year old classes and up.

The recital fee is not the same as a costume fee. The recital fee is due on March 1st and is in lieu of selling tickets or programs. Each student pays a recital fee and then may invite their entire "fan club" without the need to pay admission at the door. The recital fee covers the cost of putting on the recital, such as the rental of the auditorium and more.
